Lay Pastoral Assistants at Portsmouth Cathedral

What is a Lay Pastoral Assistant?

The Cathedral's Lay Pastoral Assistants (LPA) are trained and authorised to engage in pastoral ministry on behalf of the Cathedral, working as part of a team of clergy and laity.

We work with children and young people, the sick, the recently bereaved, the elderly, the housebound and may take communion to those unable to come to church.

In addition we provide support to the clergy in supporting baptism families and those who are about to be married.

Our Lay Pastoral Assistants focus on pastoral care, but an individual's ministry varies according to their gifts and skills, and the local situation. Their remit is wide, but basically it is all about being good neighbours!

What do Lay Pastoral Assistants do at Portsmouth Cathedral?

There are many lonely people in Portsmouth who have no-one to call on when they are in need.

If you, or someone you know....

is in need of a friendly chat
needs help with shopping
requires assistance with a medical appointment
needs help filling out a difficult form
or needs some other help

...then our Lay Pastoral Assistants are there to help!

Perhaps you have noticed someone, who may normally be a regular church attender, has been absent from the Cathedral – we could make a tactful enquiry to check that all is well.

How can I contact a Lay Pastoral Assistant?

After the main Sunday morning service, there will be a Pastoral Assistant on duty to talk with and who can take details of anyone needing help.

Alternatively, you can contact either the Cathedral Offices or speak to a Cathedral Guide who can pass on details to the Lay Pastoral Assistants.

How can I become a Lay Pastoral Assistant?

Do you have a sense of vocation to this ministry? Is this affirmed by others? Are you able to help with this area of the Cathedral's work?

Being a Lay Pastoral Assistant ministry is a vocation, not just a job. We are looking for the following qualities in a potential Lay Pastoral Assistant:

Able to demonstrate pastoral sensitivity with good listening skills
Baptised, confirmed and a regular worshipper and communicant at the
Cathedral.
Rooted and grounded in their local community, trusted by those
around them
Committed to work within the local team of clergy, ministers and LPAs
Able to undertake some study and coursework to engage in continuing ministerial development

Those interested will also need to complete an enhanced DBS (Disclosure & Barring Service) clearance and will receive a comprehensive training programme including safeguarding.


